Program

Established in 1994, McDonald International Academy (**MIA**) is a fully registered and accredited secondary school inspected by the Ontario Ministry of Education and Training.

The **MIA** Summer ESL Program aims to bring students into an authentic Canadian cultural setting, while teaching them English skills in oral communication, reading and writing.

During the morning and early afternoon, students attend English classes that are taught by **MIA** English teachers. After classes, students enjoy recreational activities, events around Toronto, and weekend trips to famous Canadian destinations including Niagara Falls. For students who are interested in future studies in North America, this program is an ideal introduction to the academic and extra-curricular life at a premier North American School.

A great deal of cultural diversity abounds at **MIA**, reflecting the multicultural nature of the city of Toronto. We encourage students to learn as much as possible about Canadian culture during their stay with us, and invite them to join our friendly, supportive and diverse learning environment.

English Class

Upon arrival, students will be given an English assessment test and placed in one of the following levels:

Level 1	Beginner
Level 2	Advanced Beginner
Level 3	Intermediate
Level 4	Advanced Intermediate
Level 5	Advanced

Mornings will consist of 4 hours of our ESL fundamentals class. ESL fundamentals teach all the skills required to obtain English language proficiency, such as vocabulary, reading, writing, grammar, and oral skills. The course content and emphasis on certain skills will vary based on each level. During the activities and outings, students are encouraged to learn English in different Canadian settings. Students are presented with a certificate after successful completion and will have the ability to speak easily with native speakers.



Afternoon Activities

The **MIA** Summer ESL Program provides a full itinerary of exciting events in the afternoons after class and on weekends.

Optional trips to Ottawa, Quebec City & Montreal and/or New York City

Students can select optional 3 day weekend trips to Ottawa, Quebec City & Montreal (QMO) and/or New York City. This is a fantastic opportunity to visit some of the most beautiful and exciting cities in North America! Both these bus tours include hotel accommodation, guided tour and free time in each city. Please note, it is the responsibility of each student to obtain a Tourist Visa for the United States prior to arrival. Meals are not included during the trips.



Airport Arrivals, Departure, & Pick-Up

Airport pick-up and drop-off services are included with the package. All flight information, including date, time and flight number, should be sent directly to our office or through your travel agent as soon as they are available. Our staff with MIA and student name signage will be in the arrival area of the airport to greet students when they arrive.

Accommodation

All students will stay at a residence facility or with Canadian families around our school area. Program fees cover only shared room accommodations. If students require a private room an extra fee of **CAD \$400 per week** applies. We will try our best to accommodate student's preferences for their living arrangements but cannot guarantee their selection due to availability. Unless traveling in a group with supervised leader, students 15 years old and younger must stay with a Homestay family. If students arrive more than 2 days before or leave more than 2 days after the start and end of the program period, extra accommodation fees of **\$100 per night** will apply. Meals and transportation fees are also the responsibility of the students during this extra time. Students who wish to arrange their own accommodation may do so by giving prior notice to the school. The accommodation fees will be deducted from the program price.

Meals

Breakfast and Dinner are covered every day in the program (except during Saturday activities and overnight trips to Eastern Canada or New York City). Hot lunches are provided during the weekdays only when on the school campus.

Laundry

Students are responsible for washing their own laundry. Please note that students may only use the laundry machine once per week.

Valuables and Cash

Passports and other valuables can be kept by the school in a secure area. Students are responsible for their own valuables if not given to the school for safe keeping. Cash can be wired to the school in advance and given to students upon arrival.

What to Bring (recommended)

- Light jacket and other summer appropriate type of clothing, ie. bathing suit
- Bath towels and other personal toiletries (toothpaste, shampoo, soap etc..)
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Knapsack or small overnight bag for weekend trips
- Pencils, pen, paper, and other stationary related to your study
- Power/Plug adaptors to suit North American plugs and voltage



HOW TO APPLY
